





## **Practical Tips**

### Why?

Clarify the purpose of consultation at the outset

A code of practice can help to enhance confidence in consultation

#### Who?

Consultation should be open & voluntary

Be specific when selecting whom to consult

Revisit stakeholder analysis throughout the consultation process

#### When?

Set a clear framework and timescale for consultation process

Align purposes
with tools of
public
consultation in
different stages
of the policy
cycle

#### How?

Use a flexible approach:

Reach out to the stakeholders

Respond to comments receive and use the input: Establish monitoring mechanism

Develop new approaches to better use ICT

Embed consultation in RIA
