The chiefs of Government of the European Union decided in the year 2000 a few reforms in order to achieve a more competitive and dynamic economy.


2. In 2005, the <u>renewed Lisbon Strategy</u> gave a new orientation to this approach. The aims that it look for are:


- § The growth across the knowledge and the innovation

- § The creation of more and better employments and workplaces
































Tenure and update of authorizations, licenses and permits.

Variety of data communication to the Administration.

Inscription in a register: registration, modification, discharge Keeping of books and / or preparation and presentation of documents, bills, statements, manuals, etc

Paying taxes: tax, fee and royalty

Training and monitoring staff training

Diligent collaboration with inspections and controls by various public administrations

Presentation of Bills to the administration or others
